Cel: In our stillness, in our openness we know ...

All: ... that in the innermost spiritual sanctum of each human being, is the real self, which is of the same essence as that spiritual reality we call God, who is within, beyond, and behind the universe;

we know

that the nature of this spiritual reality – which is unknowable to the intellect, but knowable to the heart – is love:

we know that perfect justice rules the world, that the whole creation

will one day reach its divine fulfilment;

we know this

because the world is being reconciled to God through the Lord Jesus Christ.

Cel: Christ is in you.

All: Our hope and our glory.

Cel: Lift up your hearts.

All: We lift them in joy.

Cel: Let us give our thanks to the God Most High.

All: It is a good and joyful thing to do.

Cel: It is a very good and joyful thing and all the company of spiritual worlds, in saying:

All: Holy, holy, holy,
Lord God of hosts,
who was and is and is to come,
heaven and earth are full of your glory;
glory be to you, O God Most High.

GOD HIMSELF IS PRESENT

God himself is present,
Let us now adore him
As with awe we come before him.
God is in our midst, now
In our hearts keep silence,
Worshipping in deepest reverence.
Him we know, him we name,
